IMPORTANT BILLING INFORMATION

Will I be contacted prior to surgery:

You can expect a few phone calls prior to surgery:

- ▶ You will be contacted a few days prior to surgery by a member of the nursing staff to collect a health history, to clarify instructions for the day of surgery, and to answer any clinical questions you may have.
- ▶ You may also be contacted by someone in the facility's business office to address financial matters such as your responsibility for co-payments and deductibles.
- ▶ Finally, you may also be contacted the night before surgery by your anesthesiologist to perform a clinical assessment, discuss any eating restrictions, as well as any financial responsibilities due for anesthesia services.

• Will I be billed separately by the hospital?

- ▶ Yes, before your procedure date, each patient will be notified of their estimate. The estimated amounts are due on or before the date of service.
- ▶ All estimates given are for Hospital charges only (actual charges on the final hospital bill may vary from the quoted estimate depending on the complexity of the visit and supplies/implants required). Baylor Medical Center at Uptown offers a discount for uninsured or self-pay patients. This payment is expected in full on or before the date of service.
- ▶ We accept most major commercial insurances, Medicare, Medicaid, and Workers Compensation.

• Will I be billed separately by my surgeon?

► Yes, each patient will receive a separate bill from your surgeon for his/her professional fees.

• Will I be billed separately by the anesthesiologist?

▶ Yes, each patient will receive a separate bill from your anesthesiologist provider if anesthesia was administered.

• What will happen day of surgery?

▶ When you arrive at the facility, you will be checked-in by a member of our Registration staff. Because we have obtained most of your clinical history and financial information prior to your arrival, the registration process is usually quick and simple.
